- Annual budget of k€ 970 approved in Glasgow in November 2021
- HFR 1
- € 411,376 available in 2022, including 2021 remaining amount, contributions from French and Spanish Ministries of agriculture, GIZ, Mac Donald, IEVA Group and Ird.
- € 342,668 + € 25,665 (overheads) = total spent € 368,333
- Executive Secretary (France, Germany and Spain for secondments and Cirad [value: k€ 14]), offices (value k€ 10 from Occitanie Region through Agropolis International / Alliance and k€ 4 from INRA)
- It is anticipated that the level of expenditures will let less than k€ 43 available at the end of the year




